

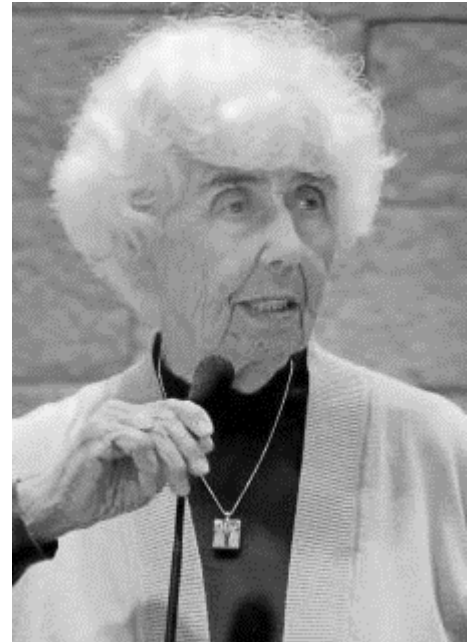


# *Holocaust Commemoration*
